More than 1,200 gymnasts and their parents will participate in the two-day meet

Dec. 9, 2008: CHESTERFIELD, Mo. --- Buzz Broadband has agreed to sponsor a visit from Shannon Miller, the most decorated American gymnast, male or female, in history, during the fifth annual "Meet Me in St. Louis" St. Louis Gym Centre Open Invitational gymnastic competition on Jan. 10 & 11, at The Club at Chesterfield, adjacent to the Doubletree Hotel & Conference Center, 16625 Swingley Ridge Road. "Meet me in St. Louis" is hosted by St. Louis Gym Centre, a not-for-profit organization and the oldest private gymnastics club in St. Louis. Men's and women's sanctioned levels 4 through Elite, and men's and women's unsanctioned levels 2 through 8 will compete. The meet is considered to be one of the top co-ed gymnastics competitions in the country.
