**\*\*\*\*IMPORTANT COMMENTS REGARDING SAFETY\*\*\*\*  
FROM DEBORAH F. CRASK, SLGC'S DIRECTOR**

All of us at SLGC have been shocked, horrified and saddened by conduct and cover up involving USAG and Larry Nasser, a former doctor, recently made public. The conduct described and disclosed in the court proceedings was abusive and criminal.

As a result of these tragic incidents, it is important to re-visit what SLGC does and has done to assure the continued safety and security of its programs.

In addition to its mission of teaching and training in the sport of gymnastics, and as a key and critical part of carrying out this mission, SLGC has always been mindful and has always strived to maintain as a paramount goal, the physical and emotional safety and security of all gymnasts, all participants, all parents, all coaches, all staff and all others involved in its programs.

To date, SLGC has not been made aware of any inappropriate relationship, conduct or behavior between coaches, staff and others and participants, team members and others, a record SLGC is proud of and one that SLGC is absolutely committed to maintain.

However, given the recently reported national events, SLGC wants to advise what SLGC does and has done to assure everybody of the steps that it has taken to assure the full safety, security and enjoyment of our programs, which include:

- + SLGC provides viewing of all classes and team practices at all times
- + SLGC maintains the presence of at least one coach or office staff present in the facility who is available to assist whenever classes or practices are in session,
- + SLGC employs no medical personnel. Any and all injuries are treated by our coaches and athletic trainers in full view
- + SLGC advises any injured participant who needs medical care and treatment to seek assistance from her or his own doctor or health care provider
- + SLGC calls the local EMS in the event of a serious injury
- + SLGC encourages open communication between and among participants, coaches, staff and parents to discuss any issues of concern
- + SLGC actively encourages all coaches, staff, gymnasts, parents and others immediately to report any activity that is believed to be inappropriate, and SLGC will immediately investigate it and take appropriate steps to remedy the situation, including reporting it to local law enforcement if merited
- + SLGC, at reasonable intervals, meets with, counsels and trains its coaches, staff and other SLGC personnel about its policies concerning safety and appropriate interpersonal behaviors
- + SLGC is always open and encourages questions, suggestions and comments to improve its gymnastic programs

SLGC values the trust and confidence all of its participants and families have placed in its mission and programs, and I am always available to discuss any questions or concerns that may arise at any time. Please just feel free to contact me.
